



Mentor- Mentee Report **Academic Session 2026-27**

Department of Mathematics conducted a departmental Meeting on **22 July 2026** in which Mentor–Mentee programme was discussed to strengthen the mentoring system and ensure regular academic and personal guidance for students. The meeting was attended by the Head of the Department and faculty members. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the mentor allocation process, review the mentoring framework and plan future interactions with students.

During the meeting, the faculty deliberated on the importance of effective mentoring in supporting students, academic progress, career planning and overall well-being. It was emphasized that regular interaction between mentors and mentees would help identify students concerns at an early stage and provide appropriate guidance.

Decisions Taken

1. It was resolved that all students of **B.Sc. Semester III, B.Sc. Semester V** and **M.Sc. Semester III** would be allotted individual faculty mentors from the Department of Mathematics.
2. Each mentor will be responsible for maintaining regular contact with the assigned students, monitoring their academic performance, addressing personal or academic concerns and encouraging participation in departmental and institutional activities.
3. Mentors will maintain records of meetings and interactions with their respective mentees for future reference and follow-up.

The department also discussed the schedule for subsequent mentor–mentee interactions to ensure continuity of the mentoring process. It was decided that the **next Mentor–Mentee Meeting** would be conducted during the **second week of August 2026**. Faculty members will review the initial mentor–mentee interactions, discuss student feedback and address any issues requiring departmental attention.

The meeting concluded with a collective commitment from all faculty members to implement the mentoring system effectively and provide continuous support to students for their academic, personal and professional development.
