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STUDENT FEEDBACK ACTION TAKEN REPORT (ATR)

Based on the survey data provided by approximately 1247 students, this Action Taken Report (ATR) outlines the strategic responses and corrective measures initiated by the college administration to address feedback across various institutional parameters.

- 1. Infrastructure and Facilities:** While 78.5% of students find classrooms and furniture adequate, a notable minority (21.5%) expressed dissatisfaction.

Action Taken: The college has initiated a phase-wise audit of all classrooms to identify and replace damaged furniture. A "Cleanliness Monitoring Committee" has been formed to ensure the maintenance of hygiene standards in all academic blocks.

- 2. Washroom and Drinking Water Facilities:** The data shows high satisfaction (over 66.7% combined for ratings 4 and 5) for drinking water and washrooms. However, washroom facilities received the highest "Rating 1" (15.5%) compared to other categories, indicating a specific pain point.

Action Taken: The Estate Office has increased the frequency of washroom sanitation cycles. Exhaust fans and ventilation vents are being upgraded in older blocks. For drinking water, AMC (Annual Maintenance Contracts) for RO purifiers have been strictly enforced.

- 3. Library:** Reference book quality received a positive response from over 66.2% of students (Ratings 4 & 5).

Action Taken: The Central Library is currently procuring 500+ new titles based on departmental recommendations.

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4. Hostel facilities: 79.1% are satisfied with the hostel facilities.

Action Taken: For the hostel, the Warden's office has established a Student Mess Committee to monitor the food quality.

5. Co-curricular Engagement: Participation data reveal that 83.9% of students participate "Sometimes," while 16.1% "Never" participate.

Action Taken: The Sports and Cultural Committees have been directed to diversify their event calendars. To boost participation, the college is introducing "Activity Credits".

Summary of Institutional Progress: The overall trend indicates a robust Administrative Support System (90 % positive rating). The college remains committed to converting all "Level 1" and "Level 2" feedback into improvement milestones over the next academic semester.

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
