Bharat BoudhIKS is a project of Vidya Bharati Uchcha Shiksha Sansthan (VBUSS) to help integrate Bharatiya Knowledge System into subject-specific mainstream education, fostering cultural roots encouraging problem-solving through traditional wisdom (encourage using traditional wisdom for problem-solving), and showcase Bharat's historical contributions. Through the publication of subject specific books on IKS and conducting a written examination, we aim to equip students with the tools to understand, appreciate, and apply these timeless principles in contemporary contexts.

Bharat BoudhIKS book series is designed to help the youth to connect with India's rich intellectual heritage. Through subject-based learning, designed to cater the need of three disciplines (**Arts, Science and Social Sciences**), it brings traditional wisdom into modern education.

- 1. Literature or books available:** Bharat BoudhIKS has developed $7 \times 3 = 21$ books in three disciplines (Science, Social Sciences and Arts) in English and Hindi language. These books concise and rich in information, at the end MCQs are given for practice.  - **Part II: Descriptive:** 1 questions × 20 mark, approx. 250 words
- **Duration:** 2 hr **Mode:** Offline (OMR + written booklet)

- Must register on **Bharat BoudhIKS** website www.bharatboudhiks.com (minimum 200 examinees).
- Each registered institute receives **21 Bharat BoudhIKS books (free)**.
- Hosting institutions may show this as IKS based activity for **NAAC/NIRF credit points**.
- **₹25 per candidate out of registration** can be retained by the center as exam expenses.

3. Guidelines for Students:

(A) Registration & Preparation

1. Register through institution and examination center before the deadline at www.bharatboudhiks.com.
2. Each student must Verify admit card details (roll no., center, timing), on his page at dashboard
3. Carry valid ID and admit card on exam day.
4. Study from VBUSS-recommended IKS books.

(B) Exam Day Instructions

1. Report **45 minutes early**.
2. Carry **blue/black pen, admit card, and ID**.
3. **No electronic devices, calculators, or notes** allowed.
4. Attempt MCQs first, then the descriptive section.
5. Write answers clearly and structurally (Intro → Points → Conclusion).

(C) Results & Certification

1. Check results on **VBUSS website** using Roll No. & DOB.
2. Download **E-Certificate** (Participation/Merit).
3. Top performers will be informed via email/phone for awards.

INSTITUTE REGISTRATION & MANAGEMENT

Step 1: Receiving Credentials

1. After payment confirmation, students receive:

3. Unique Registration ID
4. Default password (must be changed on first login)

Step 2: First-Time Login Process

When students log in for the first time:

1. Enter credentials (Registration ID and default password)
2. System prompts to change the default password

3. Create a new, secure password
4. Upload profile photo (required)
5. Complete profile setup
6. Redirect to Student Dashboard

Step 3: Student Dashboard Features

Students can access:

1. Personal profile and exam details
2. Examination information and syllabus
3. Admit card download (after admin publishes)
4. Notifications and important updates
5. Books, information and purchase interest
