

2. About ISIH

ISIH was established in 1981 in Madras now Chennai and later shifted to Kanpur in 1986 and got registered with the Registrar of Society Kanpur (UP) bearing Registration No 870/1990-91.....

3. Objectives of the Oration

3.3 Industry-Academia Interaction:

Facilitate mutual exchange between students and expert professionals through lectures, discussions, and interactive sessions to enhance understanding of workplace safety, hazard recognition, and environmental control.

3.4 Practical Safety Education:

Promote best practices in the safe handling, storage, and disposal of chemicals to prevent accidents, injuries, and environmental harm. The oration will also address emergency preparedness and worker health protection in industrial and laboratory settings.

4 Financial Commitment by ISIH

To support the annual oration, ISIH agrees to:

- Provide a one-time deposit of ₹3.15 Lakhs to the College.
- The interest earned on the deposit shall be utilized exclusively for organizing the oration each year in the name of the donor.
- The deposit shall be non-cumulative, and interest shall be credited bi-annually to the designated account maintained by the College. The details are as under:
