1. Parties to the Agreement

This agreement, made and entered on 3rd day of May 2024, is between the Talent Development Council (henceforth called TDC) with its address at 2A/121, Azad Nagar, Kanpur-208002, UP and VSSD College, Kanpur (henceforth called VSSD College), with its address Nawabganj, Kanpur-208002, UP.

The Talent Development Council (TDC) is a dynamic and forward-thinking Public Charitable Society that was founded in the year 2007 with a mission to empower and uplift the youth of our community. Through a comprehensive range of initiatives and programs, TDC is dedicated to identifying, nurturing, and harnessing the latent potential of young individuals, thereby paving the way for their brighter future.

VSSD College is a postgraduate college founded in the year 1921. It is affiliated with Chhatrapati Sahu Ji Maharaj (CSJM) University, Kanpur and approved by UGC.

2. Purpose

- (i.) The purpose of MoU is to equip young talents with the skills and knowledge necessary for successful employment.
- (ii.) Breaking down barriers by offering free training and educational resources, ensuring that financial constraints do not hinder the development of these bright minds.
- (iii.) The MoU will provide educational excellence extended beyond the classroom for students, by providing essential guidance and support to students preparing for competitive examinations.
- (iv.) TDC acts as a guiding light, offering mentorship, study materials, and a conduct learning environment to help students achieve their academic goal.
- (v.) This primary purpose of this collaboration is to foster cooperation between TDC and VSSD College in the following areas.

1. Free Training for Students: Talent Development Council (TDC) is committed to providing high-quality training to students free of cost. We firmly believe that the financial barriers should not hinder the educational and career growth of young

talents. This training covers a wide spectrum of skills and knowledge necessary for their holistic development and successful employment.

2. Internship Facilitation: TDC will play a pivotal role in connecting students with internship opportunities that align with their academic pursuits and career aspirations. Through a network of industry contacts and partnerships, students have the chance to gain practical experience in their chosen fields, further enhancing their skills and employability.

3. Add-On Certification Courses: In addition to the standard curriculum, TDC will offer students the opportunity to enrol in valuable add-on certification courses. These courses are designed to provide students with a competitive edge in the job market by equipping them with specialized skills and recognized certifications in their respective fields.

3. Coordination

4. Amendment and Termination


The terms of this MoU may be amended from time to time with mutual consent. The MoU can be terminated by any of the two institutions. This shall be affected by giving the other institution at least ninety (90) days advance written notice of its intention to terminate. Termination shall be without any penalty.

The amendment, termination and expiration of this MoU will not affect the terms of activities ongoing at the time of notification of amendment or termination and expiration unless otherwise agreed by the two parties.

5. Duration


This MoU shall come into effect on the date of signature and remain in force for two year unless terminated by mutual agreement in writing.


