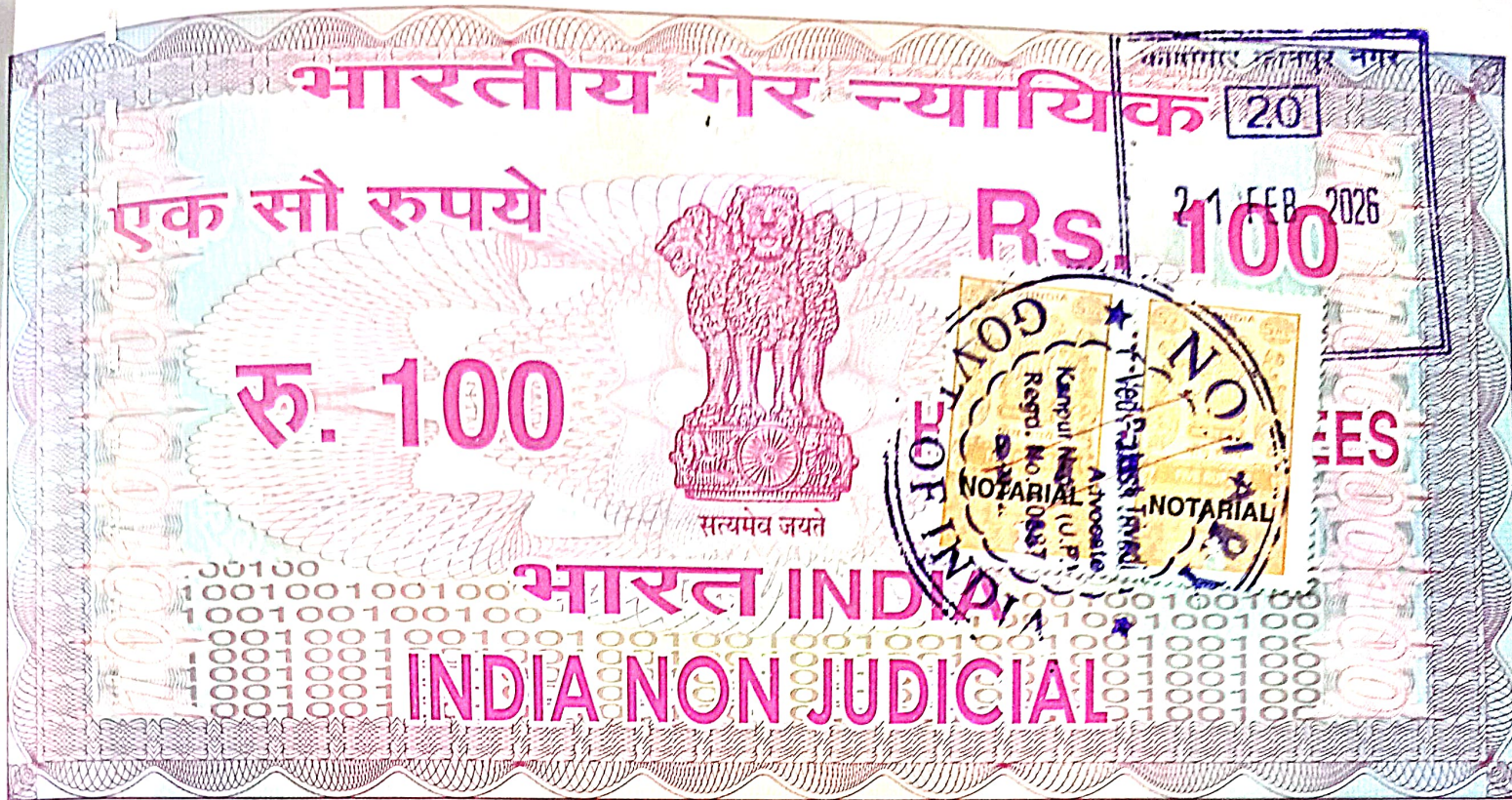

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is effective as of the 05 May 2026 by and between: Department of M.Ed., Vikramajit Singh Sanatan Dharma College, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh (here-in-after referred to as the "First Party").

&

Dr. Virendra Swarup Institute of Professional Studies, Kidwai Nagar, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh (here-in-after referred to as the "Second Party").

I. Introduction

VSSD College is one of the premier historical institutions to provide meaningful education, established in 1921 by the Brahmavart Sanatan Dharm Mahamandal under Rai Bahadur Vikramajit Singh. Situated on the banks of the Ganges in Nawabganj, Kanpur, it is an 'A' Grade NAAC accredited institution affiliated with Chhatrapati

Shahu Ji Maharaj University (CSJMU). The college is recognized for its architectural grandeur and its long-standing reputation in providing high-quality education.

Dr. Virendra Swarup Institute of Professional Studies is a distinguished institution in Kidwai Nagar, Kanpur, dedicated to cultivating skilled educators and professionals, possessing a robust B.Ed. program.

Recognizing the mutual benefits to be derived from scholastic collaboration, and united by a shared devotion to the noble craft of teacher education, both institutions hereby forge this alliance.

II. Objectives

The parties agree to collaborate for the promotion of educational excellence, training, and professional development among students and faculty. The primary objectives are:

1. To facilitate practical teaching exposure through reciprocal student internships.
2. To organize and encourage faculty exchange programs for shared pedagogical wisdom.

3. To harmonize placement cell operations to broaden career avenues for teacher-trainees.

III. Operation & Scope of Work

The parties will jointly plan and implement the following collaborative avenues:

i. Reciprocal Internship Programs

Both institutions agree to facilitate a mutual one-month internship program designed to provide practical teaching experience.

- **VSSD to VSIPS:** As the First Party offers both B.Ed. and M.Ed. programs, its scholars shall be accommodated at VSIPS for a one-month tenure. M.Ed. scholars may engage in advanced practicum, institutional observation, and pedagogical mentorship alongside the Second Party's faculty, while B.Ed. students will undertake standard teaching practicums.
- **VSIPS to VSSD:** B.Ed. students of the second party benefit from the advanced teaching of M.Ed. scholars.

ii. Faculty Exchange

A mutual exchange of faculty members shall be encouraged to foster intellectual discourse. Educators from both institutions may be invited to deliver guest lectures, conduct specialized workshops, and participate in joint seminars or faculty development programs.

iii. Placement Cell Coordination

The placement cells of both institutions shall work in tandem to orchestrate unified placement initiatives. This includes the sharing of recruitment drives, teaching vacancies, and permitting scholars from both institutions to partake in joint job fairs.

IV. Financial Involvement

Both parties will explore funding opportunities for joint programs if required. This MoU is a statement of mutual intent and does not imply any direct financial obligation on either institution unless separately agreed upon in writing.

V. Intellectual Property

Any intellectual property developed jointly during seminars, workshops, or academic discussions shall be shared as per mutual agreement. Each party shall retain ownership of its individual contributions.

VI. Arbitration

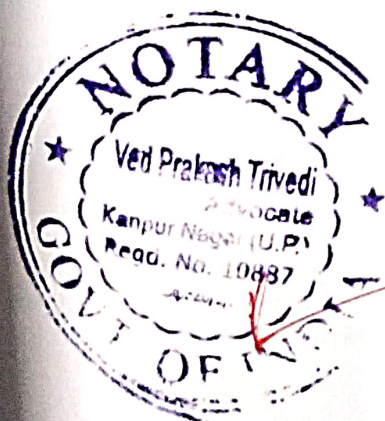
In case of any dispute or difference regarding the interpretation or implementation of this MoU, the matter shall be resolved amicably through mutual discussion. The decision of the Principal of VSSD College and the Principal/Director of VSIPS shall be final.

VII. Duration and Termination

This MoU shall come into effect from the date of signing and shall remain valid for a period of three (3) years, subject to review or modification by mutual consent. Either party may terminate this MoU by giving a prior written notice of at least three (3) months, ensuring that any ongoing student internships are gracefully concluded.

VIII. Legal Status


This MoU is a statement of intent and does not create any legally binding obligations on either party.



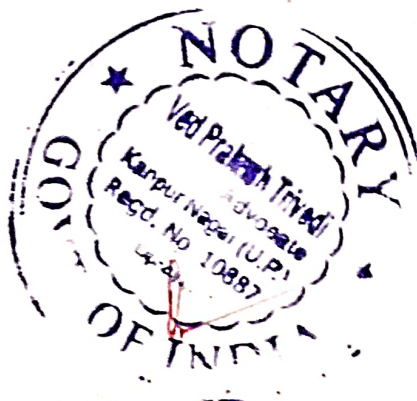


